Gear change rod assembly £25: Hubs and drive shafts £50: Front suspension arms, pins and cones £25: Steering column including wheel, indicator stalk and cowl £30: Heater unit and inline valve £25: Front headlights, 1 halogen, 1 sealed beam £5: Rear light units pair £20: Rear fog light £5: Front indicators pair £10: Vent ducts and trunking £10: Washer bottle £5: Panels in flame red - Bonnett £75, Boot lid £40: 2 very good rust free doors, including glass, all handles and winders £200: 2 chrome bumpers, rear has sheared bolts £20: 4 Rover style alloy wheels 4.5 x 12" £100: 1 steel wheel 4.5 x 12" £10: Front grille £10: New spares\_- Engine rocker cover gasket, oil filter, air filter, 4 NGKL BPRGE 6464 spark plugs, 2 gear change roll pins, 1 gearbox change oil seal and 4 sump plug copper washers, all for £15.

If you are interested in any of the above, just email me and I will check with the owner and give you his details. He lives just outside Bury St Edmunds, so you won't have to go far. The reason for the bits being available is noted on the Facebook page but essentially the owner was going to spruce up the car after acquiring it. It had been "repaired" from a CAT C write off but he found the repairs were not satisfactory and scrapped the shell.
